
HOW CAN I KNOW/MEASURE MY INTERPUPILAR/NASOPUPILAR DISTANCE?

1. OPHTHALMOLOGIST'S PRESCRIPTION

If you have an ophthalmologist's prescription, you are a lucky person! it is possible that the prescription has your Interpupilar Distance or IPD (the distance between your pupils) or your Nasopupilar Distance or NPD (the distance from each pupil to the nose). If you are going to go to an Ophthalmologist or you have one of confidence, you only have to ask for this data. This distance remains immobile from 18 years. If we know it, it will be valid for a life time.

2. MILLIMITER RULER

- Print this document in a paper as thick as possible in order to have a consistent and rigid ruler.
- Check it with a normal ruler that that the values match (some printers can change the scale).
- Cut the ruler as the image shows and fold it in the middle.
- Place the little central opening of the ruler over your nose bridge.
- Ask someone to read the distance you have to the center of the pupils or read it yourself in front of a mirror.
